We did a lot to build community and prepare for the new proposal!


- Created a community-supported BNZ professional code of conduct

Community-supported priorities for BNZ equity and inclusion work

- T1: Revisit our code of conduct to add more clear rules and transparency. How do we ensure that we are living the values embedded in that document?
- T2: Support capacity for co-learning and co-monitoring of the boreal environment in BNZ and AK communities. Build on the existing capacity for residents and Indigenous knowledge holders to use their "eyes on the land" to inform monitoring.
- T3: Improve BNZ mentoring programs, including peer-to-peer mentoring, to aid BNZ community building. Can we create a program that develops, highlights, and shares best practices?
- T4: Support our land acknowledgment with real action, in conjunction with the advisory board.
